We want you to know that your children's safety is very important to us and therefore we have implemented many changes including:

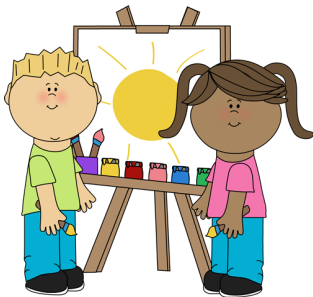
- Temperature checks for all staff and children upon entering the building.
- Limiting access to the building to only essential workers during school hours.
- Wearing masks and face shields by all staff when in the building.
- Washing hands frequently using soap and water, using hand sanitizer when soap and water is not available, and wiping all high touch areas frequently throughout the day.
- We have adjusted our schedules so classes do not cross paths with other classes in order to contact trace if needed.

Tuition : Tuition is due on the 1st and late after the 5th of the month. You have options for tuition this year. These options include:

- Paying on our Procure App:
 - ⇒ Credit card –please include a 2.75% fee. If you do not include the fee, it will be added to your invoice the next month (PLEASE add your fee).
 - ⇒ ACH withdrawal- please include a 75 cent fee. If you do not include the fee, it will be added to your invoice the next month (PLEASE add your fee).
- Bill pay – set us up with your bank as a payee and your bank will issue us a check each month. It takes 7-10 days so be sure to pay early enough for your check to reach us by the 5th.
- Personal check – you can mail a check or give us a check in the carpool line (please put it in an envelope with your child's name on it). **Please do not send checks in your child's bag or folder.**

Please note: all fees charged on the Procure App go directly to the card processing company. We do not benefit from these fees in any way



Carpool:

Thank you so much for your patience during carpool as we continue to learn the procedure together and continue to improve. Here are a few reminders:

1. For the safety of all children and families, **DO NOT PULL OUT OF THE LOADING ZONES TO GO AROUND THE CARS THAT HAVE NOT PULLED UP OR ARE STILL UNLOADING.** Please be patient and only pull up when the line moves.
2. Please have your carpool card visible in your window.
3. Phones are prohibited in the carpool line.
4. Morning carpool begins at 9:00AM and ends at 9:20 am. If carpool has ended come to the front entrance with your child and call the CDC office. Afternoon carpool begins at 1:45pm and ends at 2:15PM. All children should be picked up no later than 2:15 pm to avoid a late fee.

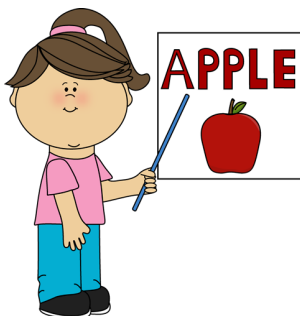

Hearing and Vision:

We will be doing our hearing and vision screening during October and November. Hearing and vision testing is required for all children in our four and five year old classes. All of our four and five year olds have already signed up for this hearing and vision testing.

We will also have a screener available to do speech and language testing October 13th - 15th. Forms will be going home soon to sign up for speech and language testing. If you feel there is a need for your child to be tested in either area, we certainly recommend following through. Speech and language testing is also available for 3 year-olds. If you have any questions or concerns in the speech or language area, we recommend that testing be done. The speech screener will be wearing a face covering.



We will be continuing our CDC Buddy program this year. Each classroom will have a volunteer from Holy Covenant UMC to be their buddy. Our buddies will be the connection between our classrooms and the church so you may see a card come home from your CDC Buddy. If you have a need that our church can help you with, you can let your teacher know and she will contact the class buddy or you can call your class buddy directly.
